

Gold Crown Championship Racers From Chevrolet, Ford and Toyota to Debut

New race car demonstration scheduled at Toledo Speedway for October 16

5 October, 2010 (Indianapolis, IN)--Gold Crown Championship race cars will be given their first public run on October 16th at Toledo Speedway. The demonstration run, staged as part of the Rollie Beale 150 USAC Silver Crown Championship Series event, are part of the Gold Crown Championship rapidly accelerating plans and will take place ahead of the 3:00 PM Silver Crown main event on Saturday.



The show is open to the media and will likely attract a healthy contingent of prospective car owners for the event. Series organizers will also be in attendance to provide additional information and answer questions about the exciting new category, which continues to solidify plans for the future. Tires for the demonstration are being provided by series partner Goodyear Tire, which will be the Official Tire for the formula.
